

Cute Cubes

You need: 6 squares of coloured memo cube paper

ACTIVITY

Silei's class is making cubes by folding squares of paper.

Memo cube squares are the perfect size, and the different colours look great!



Follow these instructions to make your own cube:

1. Crease the square along both diagonals and open it out flat.
2. Fold the top and bottom corners to the centre and open them out flat.
3. Fold the top and bottom corners to the line you made in the last step.
4. Fold the top and bottom in again along that line.
5. Flip your paper over and fold the top and bottom to the centre line.
6. Fold in each of the triangular ends.
7. Fold down the top left corner.
8. Fold up the bottom right corner.
9. Tuck these 2 corners under the centre fold.
10. Turn your shape over and fold both ends across the centre section. Leave these ends standing up.

Slide the triangular ends of 2 folded squares into the centre fold of a third folded square, one from each side.

Continue in this way until the 6 folded squares lock together to make a cube.
